He is an Advocate of the High Court of Kenya since Admission to the Bar in October 2006.

Dr. Kibugi is currently an Associate Professor at the <u>Faculty of Law, University of Nairobi</u> Prof. Kibugi is an expert and specialist in climate change law, environmental, land use, forestry, water resources governance, institutional design, public administration aspects of natural resources, legislative design and drafting, public policy, strategies, and action planning.
